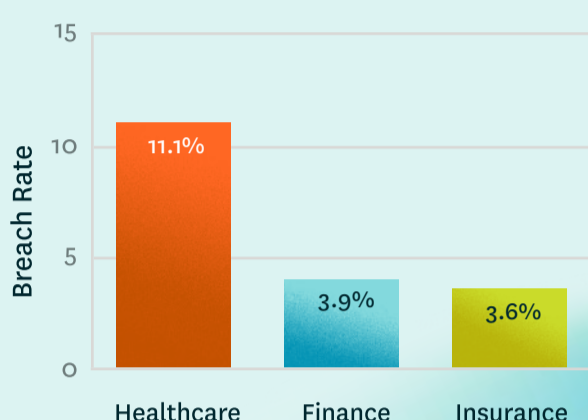
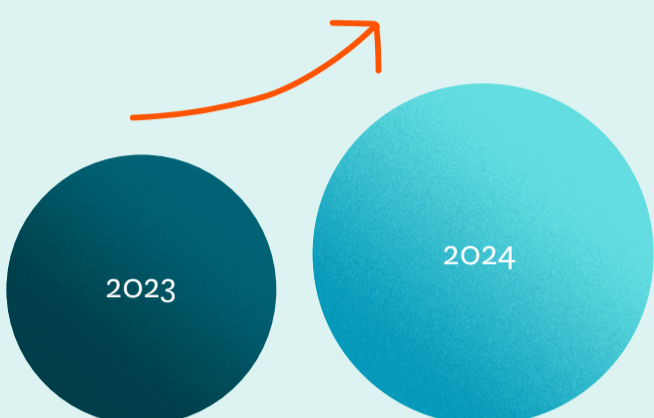
Healthcare incidents are *on the rise* and *carry more risk* than other industries

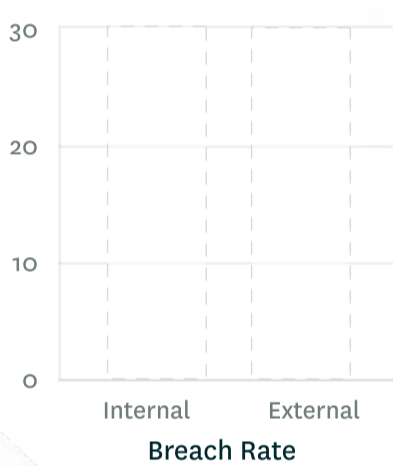
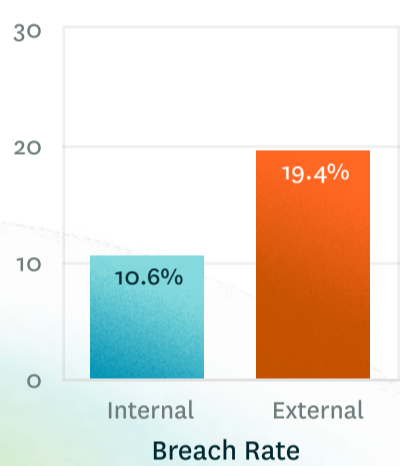

Third-party vendors are the weakest link

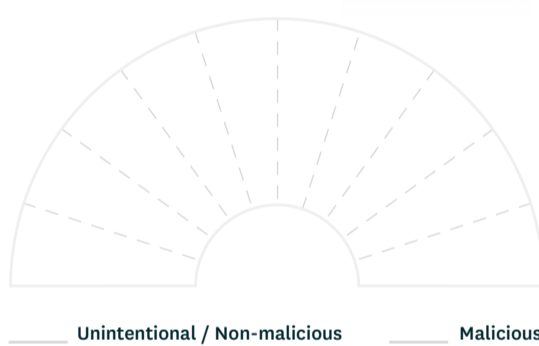
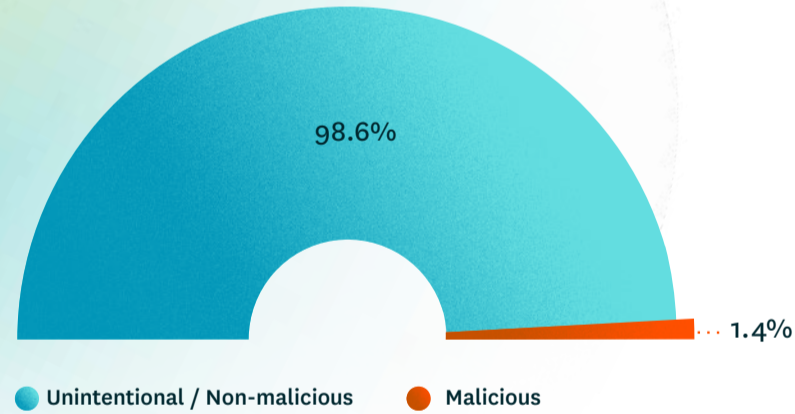

Human error far outweighs hackers

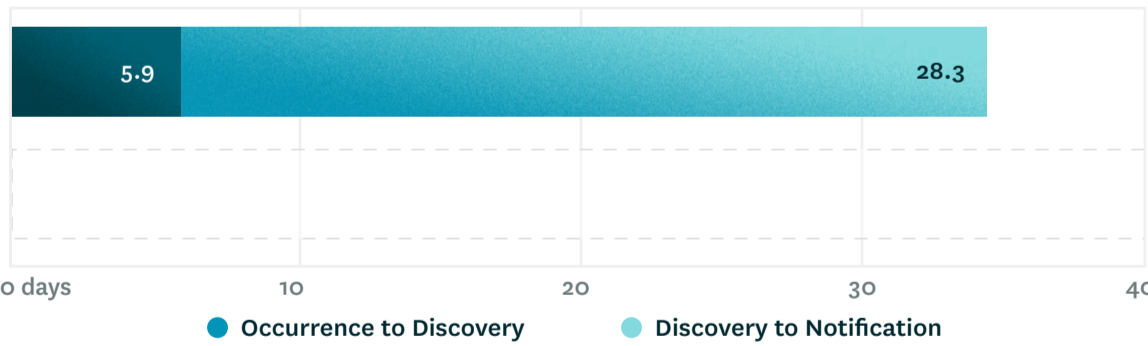
Mistakes, not hackers, are your biggest risk. How is your privacy training equipped?

Slow notification damages patient trust

Healthcare organizations experience a large number of threats to PHI and are granted a 60-day notification period under HIPAA. While 83.6% of healthcare breaches are reported on time, patients still may not view the response as swift.
